



WI-TERT REGIONAL LEADER OVERVIEW

Requirements:

- 3-5 years of experience in communications (fire, EMS or law enforcement) and currently employed by a public safety communications center
- Someone with leadership experience, is self motivated and willing to volunteer for a 1-year, 24/7 commitment
- Employing agency must support and authorize your participation
- Once selected you must maintain a membership from one of the following three organizations: NENA, APCO or SEWCRSG
- Must have a valid WI driver's license
- Must have Internet access and a personal e-mail account
- Must provide a 24/7 phone contact number
- Participation in periodic training/education sessions provided/sponsored by WI-TERT

Job Description:

- Complete WI-TERT Basic Training course
- Assist with continuing education
- Correspondence with other Regional Leaders (6 Regions), including participation in periodic meetings or teleconferences
- Deploying WI-TERT response teams, including preparing for deployment and debriefing members upon return
- Maintaining Regional contact data and deployment records
- Available as a contact when your members are called out, you will not always need to go along, however you must be available for the agency requesting the WI-TERT team

Estimated Time Commitment:

- Complete initial 3-day WI-TERT Basic Training course
- Approximately 4 hours per month for routine tasks
- Commitment to oversee deployment - time requirement will vary on a per incident basis
